

TERMS OF SERVICE

Citizens for Rasheen Aldridge

Effective date: August 4, 2026

Please read these Terms

These Terms govern your use of rasheenforstl.com and campaign-controlled pages, forms, and services. They also describe important rules for contributions, communications, website content, and third-party services. By using the Site, you agree to these Terms.

1. Acceptance of these Terms

These Terms of Service ("Terms") apply to rasheenforstl.com and any campaign-controlled page, form, or service that links to them (collectively, the "Site"). The Site is operated by Citizens for Rasheen Aldridge ("Campaign," "we," "us," or "our") in support of Rasheen Aldridge's campaign.

By accessing or using the Site, submitting information, registering for an event, volunteering, or making a contribution, you acknowledge that you have read and agree to these Terms and our Privacy Policy. If you do not agree, do not use the Site.

2. Eligibility

You must be legally capable of agreeing to these Terms. If you use the Site on behalf of an organization or another person, you represent that you are authorized to bind that party. The Site is intended for a general audience and is not directed to children under 13.

3. Limited permission to use the Site

The Campaign grants you a limited, revocable, non-exclusive, non-transferable right to access and use the Site for lawful, personal, and non-commercial purposes. No ownership rights are transferred to you. The Campaign may suspend, restrict, modify, or discontinue any portion of the Site at any time, subject to applicable law.

4. Information you provide

You agree that information you submit through the Site will be truthful, current, and complete. You are responsible for correcting inaccurate information and for ensuring that you have the right to provide any information, materials, or content you submit.

5. Contributions and payment processing

Campaign contributions may be processed by a third-party payment provider. That provider's terms and privacy policy also apply to information and payments submitted on its platform. The Campaign does not guarantee that a transaction will be accepted and may reject, cancel, or refund a contribution when required or permitted by law.

By making a contribution, you represent and certify that:

- You are legally eligible to make the contribution under applicable law.
- The contribution is made from your own funds, is not provided by another person or entity for the purpose of making the contribution, and will not be reimbursed unlawfully.
- You are not making the contribution in the name of another person or from a prohibited source.
- The contribution, together with your other contributions, does not exceed applicable legal limits.
- The identifying, employment, and payment information you provide is accurate and complete.

6. Campaign-finance disclosure

Campaign-finance laws may require the Campaign to collect, retain, and publicly report certain contributor information, such as name, address, occupation, employer, contribution amount, and contribution date. By contributing, you authorize the Campaign and its service providers to use and disclose that information as necessary to process the contribution and comply with law.

7. Refunds, errors, and receipts

Contributions are generally final except when a refund is required by law or approved by the Campaign. The Campaign may consider timely requests involving duplicate transactions, processing errors, unauthorized transactions, or legally ineligible contributions. Submit a request promptly through the contact information on the Site and include enough detail to identify the transaction. Refund timing and eligibility may depend on applicable law and the payment provider.

Transaction confirmations or receipts may be issued by the payment provider or the Campaign. Contact the Campaign if you need assistance obtaining a contribution record.

8. Email, telephone, and text communications

If you provide contact information or otherwise opt in, you may receive campaign news, event information, volunteer opportunities, fundraising messages, or requests for feedback. Message frequency may vary, and message and data rates may apply. Consent to receive communications is not a condition of making a contribution. You may unsubscribe using an email link or reply STOP to text messages where supported. Reply HELP for assistance where supported.

9. Prohibited conduct

You may not use the Site to:

- Violate any law, regulation, campaign-finance rule, or third-party right.
- Submit false information, impersonate another person, conceal the source of funds, or engage in fraud.
- Interfere with Site operation or security, introduce malicious code, scrape the Site in an abusive manner, or attempt unauthorized access to systems or data.
- Harass, threaten, discriminate against, defame, or harm campaign staff, volunteers, supporters, visitors, or other persons.
- Copy, republish, sell, exploit, or create derivative works from Site content except as expressly permitted by these Terms or applicable law.

The Campaign may block access, reject or refund a contribution, preserve relevant records, or report conduct to service providers or authorities when reasonably necessary or legally required.

10. Intellectual property

Unless otherwise stated, Site text, design, logos, graphics, photographs, video, audio, software, and other materials are owned by or licensed to the Campaign and are protected by applicable intellectual-property laws. You may view and share links to public Site pages for lawful, non-commercial purposes, but you may not use Campaign names, logos, photographs, or other content in a way that suggests endorsement or affiliation without written permission.

11. User submissions

If you submit a message, testimonial, photograph, video, design, or other material, you retain any ownership you hold. You grant the Campaign a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free license to store, reproduce, adapt, and use the submission for the purpose for which it was provided, including campaign communications, unless you and the Campaign agree otherwise. You represent that the submission does not violate another person's rights or applicable law.

12. Third-party services and links

The Site may link to or embed services operated by third parties, including donation processors, email or text platforms, social-media services, maps, video services, news sites, and event tools. The Campaign does not control those services and is not responsible for their availability, content, security, or practices. Your use of them is governed by their own terms and policies.

13. Disclaimer of warranties

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Site and its content are provided "as is" and "as available." The Campaign disclaims all express and implied warranties, including warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, title, and non-infringement. We do not warrant that the Site will be uninterrupted, error-free, secure, or free of harmful components, or that all content will always be complete, current, or accurate.

14. Limitation of liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Campaign and its candidates, officers, staff, volunteers, agents, vendors, and affiliates will not be liable for indirect, incidental, special, consequential, exemplary, or punitive damages, or for loss of data, revenue, opportunity, or goodwill, arising from or related to the Site or third-party services. Any aggregate liability arising from a contribution transaction will not exceed the amount of that contribution, except where a different limitation is required by law. Some jurisdictions do not allow certain exclusions, so portions of this section may not apply to you.

15. Indemnification

To the extent permitted by law, you agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Campaign and its candidates, officers, staff, volunteers, agents, vendors, and affiliates from claims, losses, liabilities, damages, and reasonable costs arising from your unlawful use of the Site, your violation of these Terms, your infringement of another person's rights, or information or materials you submit.

16. Changes, suspension, and termination

We may revise these Terms to reflect changes in the Site, campaign practices, vendors, or legal requirements. Updated Terms will be posted with a revised effective date and will apply prospectively unless law requires otherwise. Your continued use of the Site after an update means you accept the revised Terms. We may suspend or terminate access when reasonably necessary to protect the Site, enforce these Terms, or comply with law.

17. Governing law and miscellaneous terms

These Terms are governed by applicable federal law and the laws of the State of Missouri, without regard to conflict-of-law principles. Unless applicable law requires otherwise, disputes relating to these Terms or the Site will be brought in a state or federal court with proper jurisdiction in St. Louis, Missouri.

If any provision is found unenforceable, it will be modified or severed to the minimum extent necessary, and the remaining provisions will remain in effect. A failure to enforce a provision is not a waiver. These Terms and the Privacy Policy constitute the entire agreement concerning use of the Site, except for additional terms presented for a specific service or transaction.
